

### BIG DEALS AT DUBAI AIRSHOW 2023

- Emirates ordered 95 wide-body aircraft from Boeing worth \$52B, an order for 15 Airbus jets worth \$6B and signed deals with Safran worth over \$1.2B
- flydubai confirmed an order for 30 Boeing aircraft worth \$11B
- Ethiopian Airlines announced an order of 11 Dreamliners and 20 737 MAX 8 aircraft estimated at \$7B and signed a MoU for 11 additional Airbus estimated at \$2.43B
- ▶ Tawazun signed deals with local and international companies valued at \$6.278B
- SunExpress Airlines, placed a firm order for 45 narrow-body 737 MAX jets to be delivered between 2029 and 2035, with options or purchase rights for another 45 worth \$4.49B
- ▶ Air Arabia placed an order for 240 CFM LEAP-1A engines worth \$3.36B
- airBaltic confirmed an incremental order for an additional 30 A220-300s worth \$2.74B






